



DISTRICT 4 GUIDELINES CALIFORNIA HIGH SCHOOL RODEO SCHOLARSHIPS

To all Seniors who are Members in good standing with District 4:

Congratulations on your completion of High School and the sport of High School Rodeo. This gives you the opportunity to apply for a District 4 scholarship to continue your education. District 4 Scholarships are based on academics, need, and the goals of the applicant. Your commitment and accomplishments in rodeo, as well as your involvement at the District and State level are also evaluated. You must be planning to attend one of the following: four year college/ university, community college, or an accredited vocational or trade school.

The Scholarship Process for District 4 will include an Application Packet and Interview. To be considered for a scholarship, applicants must complete both parts of the process.

****Please note:** Verification of fundraisers and volunteer hours will be conducted.

A COMPLETE APPLICATION PACKET MUST INCLUDE:

1. **COMPLETED** District 4 scholarship application (do not leave anything blank).
2. Get an official transcript from your High School (grade 9 through mid-grades including your senior year). Official means signed and stamped by registrar.
3. Two letters of recommendation:
 - One written by someone that is not involved in rodeo (i.e.: minister, rabbi, teacher, or employer).
 - One written by a CHSRA Officer, District Officer or State Representative.
4. A letter min. 250 words typed or hand written by you to the committee explaining your qualifications for a scholarship, how you plan to use the scholarship, and what your plans are for the future.

Your complete application must be postmarked by Wednesday, February 24, 2021.
