

2022 Mid-State Classic Rodeo

We are gearing up for another great Mid-State Classic Rodeo at the Paso Robles Event Center. This rodeo will present saddles to the All-Around Cowboy and Cowgirl, buckles to reserve all-arounds, buckles to event winners, prizes to event reserve champions, prizes to rookie cowboy and cowgirl, and jackpot money paid on each go. Event winners are based on the aggregate, and All-Around Awards are based on total points. Both arenas and all stalls are covered, so the rodeo will take place rain or shine.

This is a sanctioned rodeo (points count for your district) for districts **4, 6, 7, & 9 for ALL EVENTS** and District 8 for Cutting & Reined Cow Horse & District 3 for Reined Cow Horse Only. However, any member of NHSRA is invited to compete for jackpot money and prizes.

All entries will include a \$10 jackpot fee for each event entered. Jackpot will be paid on each go.

o Camping/Stalling

Stalling and camping are completed online at time of entry, stalls are \$80 and camping is \$50.

NO PORTABLE PANELS OR TIE OUTS ARE ALLOWED ON GROUNDS

Gates will open Thursday, November 18 at 12:00 noon for your arrival.

If you plan to camp together, you must come through the gate together-no saving sites

There will be Event Center staff handling the parking, please be respectful and follow the rules.

On Friday night there will be a Team Roping Jackpot, follow the D7 Facebook and Instagram pages to get details.

Special Arena Conditions

Set-ups for Rough Stock are held on Saturday ONLY. No set-ups for Cutting or Reined Cow Horse

Team Roping will be chute run, not drawn stock. All team roping steers will run through and be picked by directors & stock contractors Friday night during the Team Roping Jackpot.

Goat Tying BOTH GOs will be held FRIDAY AFTERNOON

Reined Cow Horse will count for All Around Points for Awards only

Mixed Cutting to be determined after entries close if separated Girls/Boys sets. Cutting will begin at 8:00 am on Friday November 18th. 2nd Go will start after the completion of the 1st go

Reined Cow Horse will run Saturday evening, after the 1st go of Barrel Racing completed and arena prepped

Goat Tying: Both go rounds of goat tying will run Friday afternoon. (1st go will start after the completion of Mixed Cutting, not to begin BEFORE 3:00pm)

Mandatory ground rules meeting will be held in the grandstands at the large arena at 7:00am on SATURDAY, November 19th

Grand Entry will be at 7:45am

All trailers must be parked in designated areas. Parking violators will be towed at the owner's expense. Private motorized ATV's, scooters, motorized bikes, etc. are **not** allowed on the grounds.

Everyone must pay for camping & stalls if staying on the grounds. No exceptions!
